- A cover letter indicating why you would like to work as an Ambassador.
- Two (2) Letters of recommendation:
 - From a certified Interpreter and or a member of the Deaf community and
 - From a church leader on Church stationary (if involved in Church Deaf Ministry) or a faculty member or administrator of the ITP on Official School Letter Head
